Scientific Literacy (3-4 credits, must have SCIL attribute)
1-2 Free Elective Courses (any 3+ credit college-level course not already required for your major)
Marketing Majors: MKT 09200 Principles of Marketing. If there are no open seats in any section of MKT 09200, then you can select a 2nd course from this category. <i>You can take this course next year instead.</i> A minimum grade of C- is required as a prerequisite for upper-level Marketing courses.
