## How to Use This Guide:

**Unlike your first term, you must register for courses yourself each semester.** This guide helps you plan your schedule.

- **Step 1:** Pick one course from each required category: Composition, Math, and Economics.
- **Step 2:** Choose two electives from page 2 to complete a 5-course (15 credit) schedule.
- **Step 3:** Use Section Tally ([sectiontally.rowan.edu](http://sectiontally.rowan.edu)) to check course attributes and availability.

## Important Reminders:

- **Register on time** to improve your chances of getting a preferred schedule. Late registration limits your options.
- **Waitlisting is not recommended**—it does not guarantee placement in a specific course or section.
- Complete any outstanding placement tests, including First-Year Writing and Math, before your registration date. Otherwise, you may receive an error message when attempting to sign up for a Composition or Math course.
