General Information on SB/SE Examination and Field Exam

Mission

The mission of SB/SE Examination is to provide SB/SE taxpayers top quality service by helping them understand and meet their tax responsibilities and by applying the tax law with integrity and fairness.

SB/SE Examination has five functional operations:

- Field Examination
- Campus Examination/AUR
- Specialty Exam (Excise, Estate & Gift, Employment Tax, and BSA)
- Headquarters Examination
- Planning and Performance Analysis

Exam Hiring

FY21, Field Exam hired 867 enforcement examiners
 (RA enforcement hire = 645, RA pathways hire = 27, TCO enforcement hire = 195).

 FY22, SB/SE Exam plans to continue hiring 800 general program revenue agents and tax compliance officers (TCOs).

National Research Program

- The primary uses of NRP data are:
 - Updating return scores (more commonly referred to as DIF score)
 - Tax Gap and Compliance estimation
 - EITC and other payments for Improper Payments Elimination and Recovery Act (IPERA) of 2010 reporting
 - Issue and compliance modeling; and
 - Use by externals (TIGTA, GAO, JCT, Treasury, etc.)

- Filing season Electronic Return Originator (ERO)
